**President's Report**

Terry thanked everyone for attending and expressed gratitude to the outgoing Tennis Executive. She acknowledged the many contributions—scorekeeping, court maintenance, kitchen help, recycling, communication, scheduling, ratings, feedback, and fan support—that made the season successful. Terry apologized for any unintentional omissions.

There are a few things that happened this season within tennis that Terry wanted to make sure everyone was aware of:

- A big congratulations to our 3.5 Men's Team who finished first overall in their division. We should be proud of all the hard work it took from them to make this happen.
- This season, the men's and women's tennis teams played separately, which led to increased use of our courts. Our courts hosted league play on 32 occasions, including three when 4.5-level players visited to compete (twice for the 4.5 Men and once for the 4.5 Women).
- Silveridge Tennis has made an application to the Renters Association for funding for a VAPTR Court Cleaning Machine (the same as what Pickleball has). Our request will be reviewed on Monday March 9<sup>th</sup>.
- We were able to host at least one Fun Day each month. Thanks once again to the donors who provided money to allow us to have a Pizza Fun Day in February.
- Professional coaching was provided by Bill, and the lessons were well received. Silveridge Tennis will be offering this again next season. Tennis also wanted to thank Dean and Scott for the coaching they provided.
- A request to install a Tennis backboard was previously made. After further discussion, a decision was made by the Executive not to pursue this.
- The dog park area has been updated with paving stones, and the water issue at Court 3 is resolved. The next executive will determine if additional privacy screens are needed.
- The Silveridge exemption to play in the East Valley Seniors Tennis League (EVSTL) with 3 courts instead of 4 will be reviewed at the next EVSTL President's meeting on March 19th. Terry expects approval, as only having 3 courts did not cause any problems this season.

## **General Meeting March 8, 2026**

- Silveridge Tennis applied for funding to receive a Tennis game called Red Ball. Confirmation that we are eligible has not been received yet.
- No progress has been made on investigating a fundraising initiative to sponsor a plaque on one of our benches, to honor a loved one. The incoming executive will need to evaluate whether this matter should be pursued.

With the tennis season over, work will soon begin on Silveridge's Team Commitment Registry (TCR), which sets the number and level of teams playing here with Silveridge as the home team and where they would be playing at other resorts with that resort as the home team. Once final decisions are made, this will be shared.

EVSTL will likely use the 16-week schedule again next season, as it was effective this year. There were only a few times throughout the season where both Men and Women ended up being scheduled to play at the same park. Silveridge had one instance of this, and it was resolved by the 3.5 Men playing at The Resort.

EVSTL is considering updates to the Tenniscores system. EVSTL is questioning whether the distinctions between Lines 1-2 and 3+ are effective or simply encourage teams to exploit the rules. Are the criteria for moving up or down serving their intended purpose? EVSTL is also looking into a suggestion that has been made to potentially combine levels together. No research has been done yet on how this would work. These will be discussed at the March 19<sup>th</sup> meeting.

### **Vice President's Report**

Marty Houle wanted to thank all the volunteers that picked up, crushed and/or transported cans to the disposal facility. We had a great year with an exceptional group of volunteers. He wanted to thank the great weather for contributing to consumption from aluminum cans.

Tournament play was great. Silveridge players were well represented at tournaments and overall, this has been a successful tennis tournament season.

Marty wanted to thank the executive and the membership for allowing him to fill the Vice President position these last three years.

### **Treasurer's Report**

Mike presented a Treasurer's Report. Current membership numbers are 62. Report filed for audit.

### **Changes to Bylaws and Constitution**

Changes to the Bylaws and Constitution were sent out and posted on the bulletin board. Major changes were to add a Past President Role, redefine the Group Representatives to one male and female role and some minor changes.
