Silverside Tennis Club Covid-19 Policy

In an effort to minimize the exposure of club members and the Silveridge community to Covid-19, the following is a guidance document created by the Silveridge Tennis Club Executive Committee, and approved by majority vote of the Tennis Club membership.

- Anyone who feels sick, feverish or unwell, OR who has been exposed to someone with Covid-19, should not participate in on-court activities or tennis social events. For current timelines on resuming public activities after contracting or being exposed to Covid-19, see guidance from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC).
- It will be a personal choice for each Silveridge tennis club member to develop their own safety protocols. It will also be a choice for each Silveridge team (whether a stand-alone team or combined with another park[s]) to decide how they want to handle inquiring about the vaccination status of: a) team players and b) opponents.
- Unless required by park management, the club has no mandatory masking policy. But in the interest of health and safety, individuals are welcome to wear masks if they choose.
- Opponent clubs in EVSTL may have their own Covid-19 protocols. SR team captains should find out what that policy is and inform their team members prior to scheduling either Rec or Tencap matches. When at the opponent's facility, each Silveridge team member must respect and follow the guidelines of the club they are visiting.
- For any scheduled match, if one or more of the participating Silveridge players are uncomfortable with either the Covid-19 protocols or vaccination status of anyone in the group, that player(s) may withdraw prior to the match without penalties or repercussions. The remaining players may continue to play socially, if desired.

The Executive Committee encourages each club member to be understanding of personal choices that others make regarding Covid-19. Each member must develop their own safety precautions and respect others' choices.
