Reports

Tennis needs to decide how to handle the balls used in the ball machine. Although we believed the balls had been replaced with new ones at the start of the season, we've since discovered they were not actually new. It's likely we'll end up replacing the balls at the close of this season.

The tennis calendar was updated to include Fun Days in January and February. Rob has put it on the website.

Vice President – Marty mentioned that our can collection is lower. So far, Silveridge has only a few people signed up for the Sunland Village East Christmas Tennis Tournament.

Treasurer – Mike provided a Treasurer's report, which was filed for audit.

Property Manager – A new battery and charger were purchased. A free blower was included with the purchase. Tennis needs to consider storing our batteries out of the heat. Doug is checking into the cost of installing a canopy over the bleachers in front of Court 1.

Fundraising – A volunteer will be requested to look after the program to sponsor a bench.

Rating Committee – One potential rating may be done soon.

Web Site – Rob is looking for some pictures from the Leisure World tournament to post on the website.

Player Development – Shelly said Terry asked him to be the Beginner Coach contact. EVSTL is trying to create a program to consistently teach all new beginner tennis players.

Scheduling – Terry has been doing this until Don returns.

Recruitment – Need to come up with some ways to recruit more tennis players. Will consider putting something in the newsletter and maybe speaking at a Coffee and Donuts meeting.

Team Representatives – Diane and Shelly will remain on the Board as team representatives. Terry will ask Dale Hillstrom if he will also continue as a representative.

New Business

Complimentary Access to Courts – Gord asked if there was a way to acknowledge individuals who have made significant contributions to the tennis club. He suggested offering them free access without requiring a membership fee. Gord was informed that this is one of the goals of the Honorary Membership Program we are currently working to establish.
